Audible alarms help protect sheds and garages Break-ins to outbuildings such as sheds and garages are continuing to happen, but there are some simple steps that you can take to increase security. One of the most effective ways to do this is to fit an audible alarm that is activated when a door or window is opened. Other things you can do include:

- Fit motion sensor lights
- Plant thorny shrubs against access routes such as drainpipes and walls
- Secure valuable items within your outbuilding with cables or chains and robust padlocks
- Sign up to a property register such as http://www.immobilise.com to create a record of your property
- Good news on house burglaries We are pleased to tell you that no house burglaries have been reported in Wealden for the past five days. - Spate of damage in Hailsham town centre Police are appealing for witnesses following a spate of damage and anti-social behaviour in Hailsham town centre on Saturday (10 October). Between 4pm and 10pm windows were smashed at two shops in Vicarage Field, and in the High Street signage was damaged outside one shop, while a window was smashed at another.

Sergeant Angie Parfitt said: "Officers immediately made an extensive search of the area and investigations led to an arrest being made the same night. However, reports suggest several young people were involved. I would ask anyone who was in Hailsham town centre on Saturday evening to contact us if they saw any suspicious behaviour or witnessed any of the damage being caused."

A 15 year-old boy from the Hailsham area has been arrested on suspicion of criminal damage. He has been bailed until Sunday, 25 October while enquiries continue.
